

COVID-19 Vaccine Development

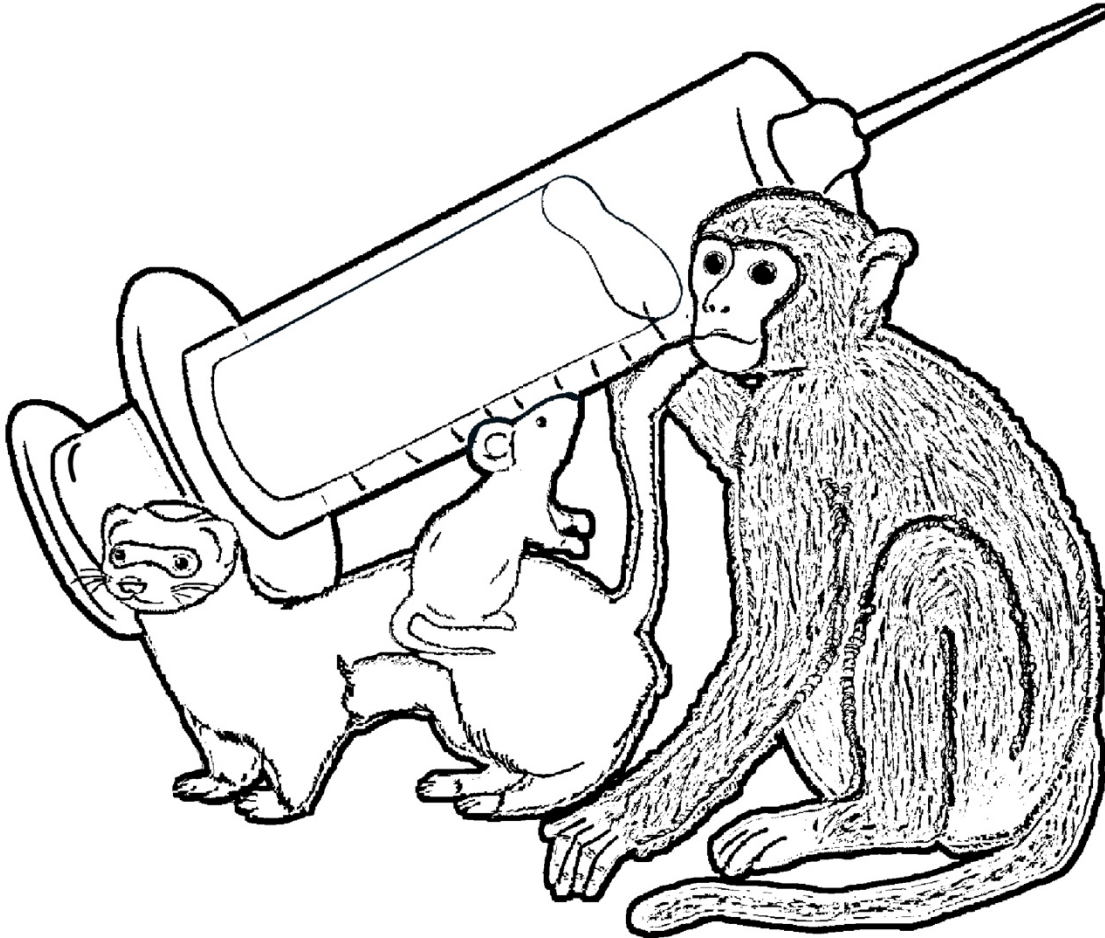
