



Enrichment Matching Game

This game allows participants to match enrichment items with the animals that use them. It is a great way to talk about all of the things we do for our research animals and ways we attempt to enrich their lives and environments.

Materials needed:

- Enrichment Matching Game board – poster version available for purchase from the BRAD store. Also available for download at www.BRADglobal.org.
- Game pieces – included with purchase of game and available for download.
- Velcro cut into 8 squares
- Prizes to give away to winners! Use BRAD freebies or order additional BRAD swag!

Instructions:


1. If you download the game from the BRAD website:
 - a. Cut out each of the game pieces.
 - b. Laminate the game board and the game pieces. This step is optional but is recommended if you plan to keep and reuse the game.
2. Stick one side of the Velcro next to each animal on the game board and the other side on the back of each game piece.
3. Instruct the participants to match the enrichment item to the animal that uses it.
4. Prizes can be given for participating in the activity and correctly matching the enrichment items to the animals.

Enrichment Item Key:

1. Chinchilla – dust bath house and Nyla bone
2. Rhesus macaque – paint roller with birdseed, turf feeder with birdseed, and challenger ball with Prima Treats
3. Dog – frozen broth in a cup, Kong, and star explosion toy
4. Marmoset – paper bag filled with treats, wood saplings, and wood splits
5. Mouse – nestlet, mouse house, and nesting material
6. Pig – scented apple and scented jolly ball
7. Zebrafish – plant
8. Rabbit – dumbbell and dental chew


